

A valid PHOTO ID must be presented to purchase a day pass or redeem a complimentary guest pass for individuals 16 and older.

All guests of the Oshkosh Y must register at the Front Desk before enjoying the Y

All guests must be age 8+ or be supervised by an individual age 16+ during their entire visit

Youth under 8 may accompany an individual 16+ who is purchasing a pass with a youth daily pass or membership.

CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 8 Must always be under direct supervision of a parent/guardian unless enrolled in a staff supervised program or activity. Members: Child Watch is available for supervision of children 6 weeks through 7 years old.

CHILDREN AGES 8+ Allowed to use the appropriate spaces available without direct supervision during non-school days/hours. Children who are independently using the Y must be able to read, follow all policies as noted, and provide the Y emergency contact information.

REDEMPTION OF OSHKOSH Y COMPLIMENTARY PASSES: Depending on the type of membership you select; the Oshkosh Y primary member may share a guest pass with a nonmember or family member. The Oshkosh Y member must be present and remain at the Y during their guest's visit. A PHOTO ID is required of a guest age 16+ and each guest household is limited to 3 visits per calendar year. Please register your guest as the Front Desk upon arrival. The Oshkosh Y is unable to accept any previously issued paper passes and is not able to honor any virtual passes from other Y's. All paper free passes issued prior to the pandemic are null and void.

The Oshkosh Y will honor a total of 3 free passes per household per calendar year (reminder all free pass guests must be accompanied by an Oshkosh Y member).

All individuals age 16+ must present a photo ID to redeem a free pass or purchase a daily guest pass. The Y will enter you into our database and take your photo. This is required, no exceptions.

The Oshkosh Y is a state licensed childcare and Oshkosh Area School District 4K site. Because of the services we offer the children and families in our community, the Y has a zero-tolerance policy on any individual who is an active registrant on a sex offender registry. The YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.

All members and guests agree to follow the Oshkosh Y Membership Code of Conduct and the CORE Values of the YMCA. Failure to do so will result in result in the forfeiture of fees paid and expulsion from the Y.

Dress Code: Sexually explicit conversation or behavior; any sexual contact with another person.

Attire: Please embrace the family friendly environment of your Y. Any clothing considered an undergarment should not be worn alone. Sports bras are considered an undergarment. Members cannot wear inappropriate, immodest, or sexually revealing attire. Swimsuits are only to be worn in the pool areas. Dress pants, jeans or other items with rivets, buttons or zippers that may damage the upholstery are not allowed.

Shirts and closed-toed shoes are required in all Health & Wellness areas (which includes indoor track and gyms). The following classes are exempt from wearing shoes during class: Water Aerobics, Yoga, Pilates, Eccentrics and Tai Chi. All other group exercise classes and within the wellness center do require wearing closed toed shoes for safety.

Oshkosh YMCA Members Complimentary Passes Per Calendar Year:

Qualifying Adult, Family, and One Adult / children Membership: receive a total of 5 free guest passes per membership household per calendar year.

Qualifying Young Adult, Six Month, and ALL Financial Assistance Memberships: receive 2 free guest passes

Qualifying Youth Memberships: receive 2 free guest passes:

Youth guests must meet the age requirements of being alone in the facility and be able to provide their address, birthdate, parents name and emergency contact information

Medicare Advantage Insurance Members (like Silver Sneakers) and Summer Members may enjoy a total of 2 free guest passes

Additional Information:

- o Any high school age guest and older must provide a photo ID
- o Passes are per household membership and not per person
- o Free passes belong to the primary member on a membership. A child on a membership is not authorized to assign a free pass unless the primary/parent member is present.
- o The primary/parent must take responsibility for their child's guest at the Y
- o Complimentary passes issued from other Y's are not accepted.

Oshkosh Y members are encouraged to contact the Membership Team should you have a special circumstance in which an exception might be made. We understand you may have an out of town guest or family member who is assisting you and we would be happy to do what we can to accommodate your special request.
